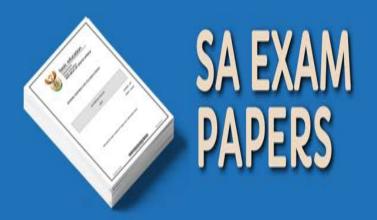

- 11. Write neatly and legibly.




SECTION A: ESSAY

QUESTION 2

- Spend approximately 40 minutes on this section.
