



TOURISM TO ISRAEL COLLAPSES AS WAR RAGES

Amid Israel's ongoing war with the Hamas terrorist organization in the Gaza

Strip, tourism is in a state of collapse with a 90% drop in visitors in November, according to Israel's Tourism Ministry.

A mere 38,000 tourists entered Israel last month, compared to 370,000 during the same period last year, the ministry's figures show. Sixteen thousand came from the United States and nearly the same number from Europe.

For now, the majority of the country's 56,000 hotel rooms are being used to house the evacuees, with the government paying the hotels over 1 billion shekels (\$273 million) a month for the services. The Israel government wants to give the Tourism industry a boost soon as the area is safe.

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

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


